Required qualifications:

- Doctoral degree from domestic or overseas university (conferred within last 5 years)
- Eligible for appointment as a research fellow at SKKU's affiliated units (colleges, graduate schools, departments, affiliated institutions, affiliated research institutes, etc.)

Preferred qualifications:

- Being recommended by a full-time SKKU professor or advising professor at SKKU

CONDITIONS & COMPENSATION

- Contract: One year (renewable up to three years according to evaluation)
- Compensation: 1,500,000 ~ 3,000,000 KRW a month, plus severance pay, employment insurance, and housing
- Other benefits:
 - Supporting joint-research through linkage with SKKU's research units relevant to the researcher's areas of focus
 - Providing airfare and short-stay housing fees additionally for those overseas R/F who are considered to have outstanding research competitiveness and potential

- Performance evaluation after two years by the university
- Submission of final research performance report within three years, which includes acknowledgement of his/her research results; contributing fund, affiliated institutions, main author and co-authors)
