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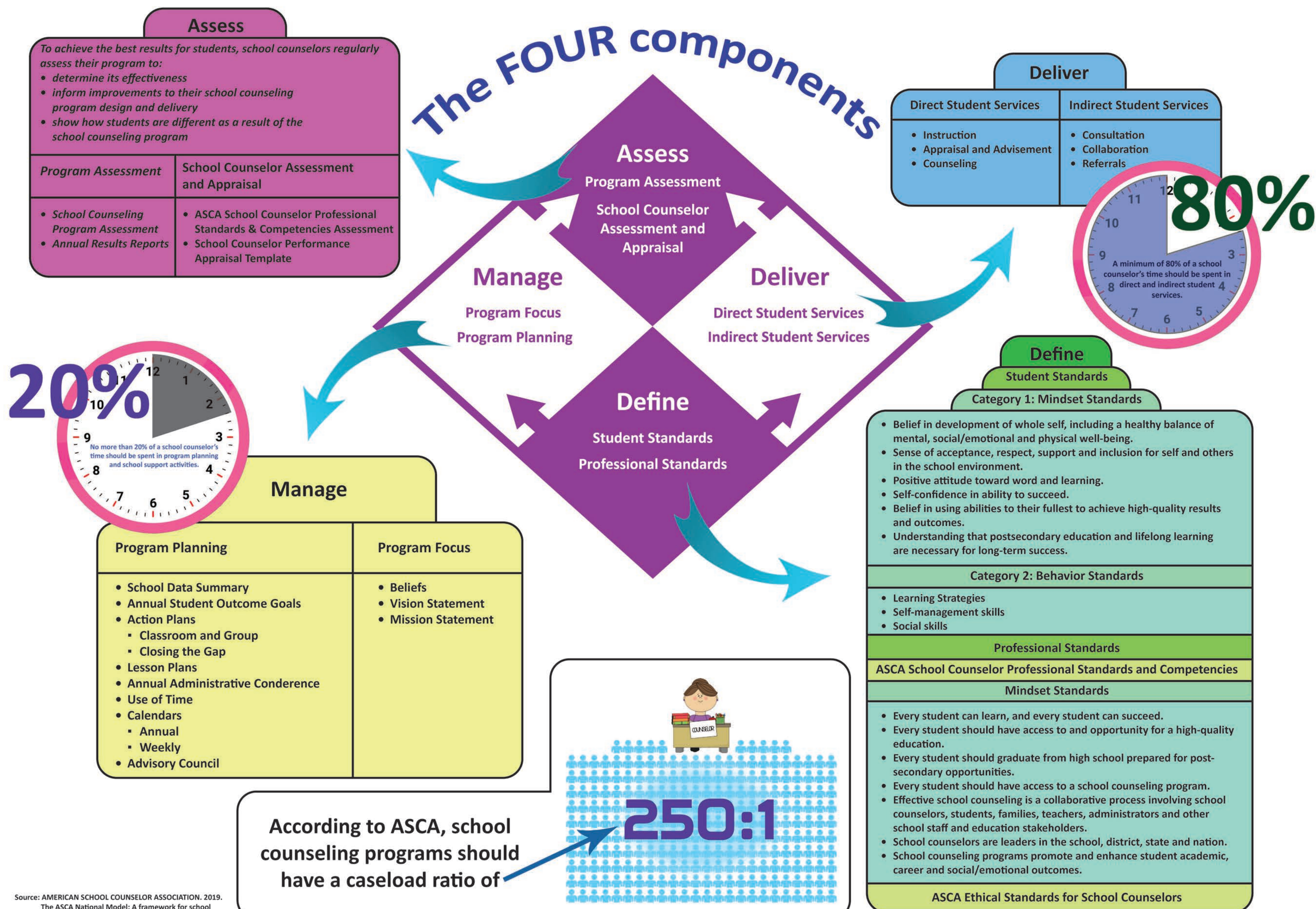
Who are School Counselors?

- ▶ Uphold American School Counselor Association ethical and professional standards.

What is the ASCA National Model?

The ASCA National Model outlines the four components of a school counseling program that are integral to the school's academic mission and are created to have a significant positive impact on student achievements, attendance and discipline.
