## **Privacy notice for the Student applicants, Master's degree candidates and PhD candidates at Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski"**

Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski" (hereinafter referred to as "the Controller", "the University" or "we") performs its activities in accordance with the Higher Education Act and the secondary legislation, the Personal Data Protection Act and the EU Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data. This document aims to inform you about all aspects of the collection and processing of your personal data by the University and the rights you have in relation to that processing.

### **What personal data does the University collect for you as student applicant, Master's degree candidate and PhD candidate, for what purposes and on what legal grounds?**

The University collects and processes the following categories of personal data in order to carry out the admission campaigns at Sofia University for application in a Bachelor's or Master's degree levels as well as for conducting competitions for PhD candidates:

**1.1.** Your name, personal identification number, e-mail address, address, telephone, citizenship, completed secondary and university education, etc. - This information is provided by you when you apply for a student application campaign, admission campaigns for Master's degree level, or conducting a campaign for PhD candidates and after your successful classification (enrollment) your personal data is collected for the purpose of enrollment as a student in your chosen major.

The University processes these data in compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject and for performing its activities in accordance with the legislation.

**1.2.** Health status, etc. - In some cases, for the purpose of providing conditions, complied with the health status of the applicants, it is necessary to provide us with information for your health status. The University processes this data on the ground of your explicit consent.

The University does not process any more data about you than is necessary for the admission.

### **How does the University store your personal data?**

The University keeps the personal data of the student applicants, the Master's degree candidates and the PhD candidates for the entire period of the admission campaign and after the admission for the entire period of the student's study until the completion of the educational qualification degree, after which the student and PhD files are archived and are stored for an unlimited period of time for the purpose of preserving the legitimate interests of the University.

The University stores your personal data in a secure, controlled access environment by taking adequate measures to prevent unauthorized access to or loss of your information, breakthroughs in our information systems, data destruction, etc. In the event that there is a risk of breach of the protection of your personal data, we will take appropriate actions and inform you promptly.

## **What rights do you have with respect to your personal data that the University processes**

You may ask the University to give you access to the personal data processed for you, to request rectification or completion of your information, to receive the data processed for you in a machine-readable format, to object to the processing of your data, limit their processing, and withdraw your consent to processing, or request that all data be erased if the conditions and legal prerequisites are met.

You can exercise your rights by requesting by e-mail or on-site at the Students' Department of the relevant faculty where you are enrolled.

## **Who can we provide your personal information to?**

The University processes your personal data as a controller and, if necessary and solely for the purpose of carrying out its activities, may transfer your personal data to third parties - data processors.

It is possible, at the request of a state or judicial authority, and subject to a legal obligation, the University may disclose your personal data, including for national security purposes.
